A study conducted by the Florida Solar Energy Centre confirmed that homes with a metal roof had attics that were approximately 35% cooler than homes with asphalt shingles. And yes, you guessed it--a cooler attic means a cooler and more energy-efficient home. Not only will your home be more comfortable, your air conditioning bills will be lower.

Installing a metal roof can help your home with a number of issues besides cooling costs. Increasing the energy efficiency in your home can also help with moisture on window panes, peeling paint and mold.

Additionally, there is much less maintenance required on a metal roof than asphalt shingle roof, so you will spend much less time and money on repairs. The fact that a metal roof keeps a more constant temperature results in a reduction in thermal shock (*cool rain hitting hot roof*) which ultimately cuts down on the stress and degradation of your roof.

Besides the money saving reasons, there is an important environmental reason why you should consider a metal roof. In large urban areas there are now many occurrences of hot zones, where the dark asphalt roofs on homes are absorbing heat and releasing it back into the atmosphere at night. This phenomenon causes the temperature to be as many as 12 degrees higher than surrounding areas, causing increased smog and poor air quality. A metal roof can reduce this problem and make the air around you easier to breathe.
